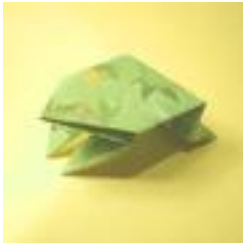
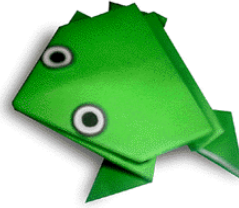


Fun Frog Craft – Origami Jumping Frog

Materials Needed:

- Paper –rectangular shape, various sizes and type (origami, construction, copier, or card stock)
- Markers or crayons
- Paper clips (optional)

Instructions

An easy craft for your students to try is an origami jumping frog. First you will want to choose a version that is best for your group. Once their frog is complete, they can color and decorate. When they press down on the frog's back, it will jump. Have them experiment with smaller and larger frogs made from different kinds of paper, such as copier paper, construction paper, etc. Which frogs seem to jump the best? You might also have your group experiment with several paper clips by placing them on different parts of the frog's body to see if it helps their frog jump better.
